Resolution No. SVL-MAC 2021-002

RESOLUTION REGARDING: Speed Reduction

Narrative:

Speeding cars within Spring Valley Lake has become a health and safety issue in our community. Continued instances of speeding present a danger to residents and their children.

Whereas:

- Spring Valley Lake is a densely populated area relative to most unincorporated areas of San Bernardino County.
- Speeding is enforced by the California Highway Patrol and they lack the manpower to properly patrol and enforce.
- Spring Valley Lake has a lack of sidewalks forcing residents to walk in the roads and around parked vehicles. This is further exacerbated by the presence of parks and increased bicycle riders in the community.
- Spring Valley Lake does not have street lights, night time walking exacerbates the danger of speeding.
- Speeding is a consistent issue in the community.
- The County installed two speed bumps on one street and apparently has no further action planned.

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Spring Valley Lake Municipal Advisory Council (MAC) on behalf of its members, requests that the County continue the study and installation of proper and acceptable speed humps to mitigate the risk of speeding vehicles in this densely populated neighborhood of San Bernardino County. Specifically, the MAC requests:

- Further investigation of the proper speed bumps/humps/tables for this community that will slow vehicles to the posted speed limits.
- Further investigation of the proper location of such.
- Request the County to share gathered data/information/conclusions from the study conducted with the two speed humps on Rain Shadow.
- Partner with the community through the MAC on this process.
