

## Spring Valley Lake MAC Minutes

- I. **Called to Order** by Dennis at 8:30 am
- II. **Roll Call**- All Members present
- III. **Approval of Agenda**- Motion made by Mary, seconded by Bo; Unanimous
- IV. **Approval of Minutes**- Motion made by Graeme, seconded by Bill; Motion carries, Bo abstained
- V. **Public Comment**

Rory Shannon spoke to the MAC to address concerns on the potential of a new well on two vacant lots in the community, opposition to any plans to tear down and replace the Archway, and the issue of speed humps in the community.

### VI. **Public Safety Reports**

- A) Officer Mike Munford of the CHP spoke regarding street parking and parking enforcement and answered related questions from members. Additional questions were asked about the status and number of officers present in the High Desert.
  - a) The MAC requested that Supervisor Cook's office investigate the possibility of altering County ordinances regarding street parking.
- B) Officer Munford addressed community concerns regarding safe and legal operation of Golf Carts on roads and highways, providing vehicle codes on what is or is not allowed to operate on roads.
- C) Members of County Public Works addressed the MAC to discuss issues related to speed bumps and the potential for posting new signage around areas of high-speed concern.

### VII. **Correspondence**

- A) Joseph Brady, community member, provided correspondence related to street cleaning notifications.
- B) Rory Shannon, community member, wished to address solid waste concerns and the potential for rate increases.

### VIII. **Information Items**

- a) Steve Samaras of Public Works Special Districts Division continued his presentation regarding CSA-64.
- b) The MAC will look to seek community input regarding what to do with the Archway.
- c) Mr. Samaras went over the expenses from the Santa Fey Maintenance Yard
- d) Continued Discussion on the space between the wall on Yates rd and homes on Driftwood rd. Mr Samaras informs the MAC that space is private property, and outside the jurisdiction of Public Works.

**IX. Field Representative Report**

Samuel Shoup reported that the Public Works department does have a planned extension of the sidewalk on Ridgecrest rd in the works, but they are awaiting approval of multiple grants. Additionally, the Supervisor's office has been in touch with Public Works regarding previously mentioned Speed Bump concerns, they informed the office that the trial run of new speed bumps has shown a reduction in overall speed.
