## San Bernardino County 1st District Oak Hills Municipal Advisory Council

### **Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance** (Time: 6:08pm)

- I. **Roll Call**- All members were present, with the exception of Member Engeron and Chair Palscik. Chair Palscik would arrive during public comment.
- II. **Approval of the Agenda**- Agenda was approved as presented. Motion made by Member Harris. Second by Member Flynn. Vote was 3-0, with Member Engeron and Chair Palscik absent.
- III. **Approval of the March 10, 2025 Meeting Minutes**- Minutes were approved as presented. Motion was made by Member Flynn, seconded by Member Harris. Vote was 3-0, with Member Engeron and Chair Palscik absent.
- IV. **General Public Comment**- Jesse Granado expressed concerns regarding a sinkhole near Aster and Farmington. Jared Beyler from the CSA was on-hand and gave his contact information to Mr. Granado. Chair Palscik arrived at this point. Kim Sheriff expressed concerns with the Amazon facility and increased traffic on Phelan Rd.
- V. **Agency/ Public Safety Reports** – Jared Beyler from CSA 70J provided a water report and answered questions. Sgt. Malensek from the Sheriff’s Department presented statistics and answered questions.

### **Action Item**

- VI. **Discuss and Take Possible Action on Resolution Opposing the Summit Estates “Half-way House”**- The Secretary read a report/update provided to the 1<sup>st</sup> District Office by code enforcement and read the resolution that was composed by the Chair and the Secretary. Member Harris suggested one change to the last paragraph, which was accepted by the board. Prior to the change it read “...all unpermitted and illegal activities...”, after the change it read “...all unlicensed, unpermitted, and illegal activities...”. Motion to approve the resolution with the noted change was made by Member Flynn and seconded by Vice Chair Cannon. Vote was 4-0, with Member Engeron absent.
