**A Resolution of the Oak Hills Municipal Advisory Council Regarding the Proposed
Residential Treatment Facility on Coriander Drive**

WHEREAS, San Bernardino County's Zoning Administrator will hear a proposal on January 29th, 2026 for a Licensed Residential Care Facility to be placed in the community of Oak Hills;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Advisory Council was created by Supervisor Paul Cook to represent the interest of the community of Oak Hills and advise his decision-making;

WHEREAS, the community of Oak Hills has previously expressed strong opposition to the placement of a similar project on Jenny Street;

WHEREAS, families choose to live in Oak Hills for its quiet, safe environment removed from business and large establishments;

WHEREAS, this project would involve the placement of 18 residents requiring 24-hour medical supervision in areas involving substance abuse and addiction recovery;

WHEREAS, the community of Oak Hills believes this to be incompatible with the rural-living zoning and the orientation of the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the OAK HILLS MUNICIPAL ADVISORY COUNCIL requests that the San Bernardino County Zoning Administrator reject the proposed application for the project on 6748 Coriander Drive.
