Call to Order- 6:00pm (All members present)

- I. Approval of the Agenda-** Motion to approve made by Vice Chair Boyd, seconded by Member Hardy; Vote was 5-0.
- II. Approval of the Amended February 18, 2025 Meeting Minutes-** The Secretary explained the corrections. Member Richman made the motion to approve. Seconded by Member Lawrence. Vote was 5-0.
- III. Approval of the Minutes of the March 18, 2025-** Member Richman made the motion to approve. Seconded by Member Hardy. Vote was 5-0.
- IV. Public Comment-** None.
- V. Information/Non Action Items**
 - a. Update on Spring Valley Lake Archway Removal and Landscaping Project, including anticipated project timeline-** The secretary provided an update on the project and anticipated timeline. The secretary said he will clarify demo timeline, detours, closure times, per the MACs instructions.
 - b. Discussion on proposed CSA water and sewer rate increases-** The MAC discussed the proposed water and sewer rate increases. The Secretary expounded on the increases, providing information on costs and timeline.
- VI. Action Items –** Chair Walters announced his resignation between items.
 - a. Discussion and possible action on a proposed resolution on Ridgecrest Wall Improvements-** The Secretary provided information on responsibility for wall maintenance and what agreements would be required to proceed. The MAC reviewed some renderings provided by the Secretary and directed the secretary to return with additional renderings per their direction. The MAC reached consensus on locations of where they'd like metal signage. Some additions were made to the resolution, as well as direction to include an addendum regarding the desired design, to be brought back for approval with the resolution.
- VII. Supervisor's Office Report-** The Secretary provided an update on Fishing Hole 9 landscaping, and the power washing of calcium buildup on the wall along Yates Rd. The MAC asked the Secretary to inquire regarding the concealment of the equipment at Fishing Hole 9.
- VIII. Council Member Comments-** Member Hardy expressed concerns about speeding on Vista Point and asked the Secretary to inquire with DPW on the matter. The Chair and Vice Chair expressed concerns with e-bikes, and the Chair mentioned sending information to the HOA General Manager on costs for contracting with the Sheriff's Department. Questions regarding the timeline and funding of the Vista Point/Bluff Crest and Ridgecrest Rd intersection were also brought up. The Secretary said he would confer with DPW.
