Call to Order- 6:00pm (All members present, with the exception of Vice Chair Boyd)

- I. Election of M.A.C. Chair-** Chair called for public comments on items I and II, there was none. Member Richman motioned that Chair Walters continue as Chair. Seconded by Member Lawrence. No other nominations were made, and Chair Walters was voted in as Chair by a 4-0 vote, with Vice Chair Boyd being absent.
- II. Election of M.A.C. Vice Chair-** Member Hardy motioned that Vice Chair Boyd continue as Vice Chair, Member Lawrence seconded. No other nominations were made. Vote was 4-0 (with Vice Chair Boyd absent) in favor of Vice Chair Boyd continuing as Vice Chair.
- III. Approval of the Agenda-** Motion to approve made by Member Hardy, seconded by Member Richman; Vote was 4-0 with Vice Chair Boyd absent.
- IV. Approval of the Amended Minutes of the November 19, 2025 Meeting-** The Secretary explained that one correction needed to be made to the minutes from November. Motion to approve made by Member Richman, seconded by Member Lawrence; Vote was 4-0 with Vice Chair Boyd absent.
- V. Approval of the Minutes of the December 17, 2025 Meeting-** Motion to approve made by Member Hardy, seconded by Member Richman; Vote was 4-0 with Vice Chair Boyd absent.
- VI. Public Comment-** A member of the public thanked CHP and the MAC for the e-bike education. Staff from State Senator Valladares' Office introduced themselves and provided an update. CHP Officer Santillan provided a brief intro and answered questions. Sgt. Rios from the Sheriff's Department introduced himself and provided some stats.
- VII. CSA-64 (Greg Snyder) Q & A with M.A.C. Members on CSA-64 Activities-** Greg provided an update, addressed questions provided by the Chair, and answered other questions from the Chair and MAC members. Discussed CSA-64 related projects.

 - a. Update on Resolution on Long-Term Street Parking-** The Secretary provided an update on the ordinance and communication with CHP on enforcement.
 - b. Ridgecrest Wall improvements discussion-** Deferred to the next meeting.
 - c. Discussion on non-golf carts usage on streets-** The Secretary provided information from County Counsel regarding golf carts and low speed vehicles and how to reclassify low speed vehicles as golf carts for purposes of Spring Valley Lake. It was decided to take this up in June.
 - d. Update on Spring Valley Lake Archway Removal and Landscaping project-** The Secretary provided an update on the timeline for bid package.
- IX. Supervisor's Office Report-** The Secretary provided an update on Bear Valley Bridge project timeline, new Captains for CHP and County Sheriff, red curbing at Spring Valley Lake Pkwy and Country Club. Chair Walters mentioned wanting to figure out more enforcement mechanisms for the long-term parking issue. The Secretary will follow up on various items.
