- I. Approval of the Agenda-** Motion to approve made by Member Lawrence, seconded by Member Richman; Vote was 3-0.
- II. Approve Amended Minutes of the May 20, 2026 Meeting-** Changes were noted. Motion to approve was made by Member Lawrence and seconded by Member Richman. Vote was 3-0.
- III. Approve Minutes of the June 17, 2026 Meeting-** Motion to approve was made by Member Richman and seconded by Member Lawrence. Vote was 3-0.
- IV. Public Comment-** One comment on wanting the arch to be renovated.
- V. Community and Agency Reports-**
  - a. San Bernardino County Sheriff-** None
  - b. CHP-** Gave some e-bike related information and states. Answered MAC Member questions.
  - c. CSA 64-** Water report was distributed, no representative present..

### Information/Non Action Items

- VI. Ridgecrest Wall Painting Update-** San Bernardino County Public Works presented on challenges associated with painting the wall. The MAC will bring this back for further discussion next month as painting was said to have a short lifespan, and there are challenges with long-term maintenance and funding.
- VII. Spring Valley Lake Archway Removal and Landscaping Project Update-** The Secretary provided an update. The Secretary said he would also notify the HOA when he gets a start date.
- VIII. Illegal Long-term Street Parking Enforcement-** The Secretary provided an update. Public Works is looking into the suggested 3<sup>rd</sup> part enforcement option.
- IX. Vinyl Wrapping of Utility Boxes at Fishing Hole 9-** The Secretary let the MAC know that Public Works was getting a quote for vinyl wraps, and showed them pictures of the influence they are drawing on for the wraps. The Secretary said he would follow up on the status of the hydroseeding/grass.
- X. Supervisor's Office Report-** The Secretary provided an update on Pahute/Parkway visibility during council member comments as he was asked about it at that time and neglected to mention it during the Supervisor's Office Report.
- XI. Council Member Comments-** Member Lawrence expressed safety concerns with the timing of the u-turn and on coming traffic light at Yates/Park Rd. The Secretary said he would look into it. Pahute/Parkway visibility was brought up again by Member Lawrence. The Secretary let the MAC know what Public Works solutions were and there was consensus for Public Works to address as they see fit.
