  - a. Vista Point Traffic light expedite project-** Christopher gave an update on information provided by Public Works as to the timeline of the project. Members requested information on the history of the Ridgecrest and Pebble Beach traffic light, as well as accident report for Vista Point crossing. Christopher said he would try to get Public Works at the next meeting to answer their questions.

- VI. Resolution on Long-Term Street Parking** (Item was moved to after Item VII)

Options for long-term street parking were discussed. Chair Walters provided a table with options, as well as definitions in order to make the discussion easier. Discussion ensued on the various options. Motion was made by Member Hardy to update the resolution to include no parking for commercial vehicles, except while loading or unloading, or servicing, and in regards to RV's/Trailers, that they be required to move 500ft after parking in a location for 72 hours, while also emphasizing enforcement. Second made by Chair Walters. 5-0.
- VII. Spring Valley Lake Archway** (Item was moved up to after V)

Christopher provided the cost estimate from Project Management for a refurbishment of the arch. Members discussed how to proceed. Chair Walters motioned to ask the 1<sup>st</sup> District BOS Office to explore funding opportunities and a timeline for a complete demolition of the arch. Second was by Member Hardy. 5-0.
- VIII. Supervisor's Office Report-** Christopher provided a report on the cost of painting the block wall along Ridgecrest, shared information regarding storm drains, and provided updates on certain signage in Spring Valley Lake.
