I. Approval of the Agenda- Motion to approve made by Member Hardy, seconded by Member Richman; 5-0

- II. Public Safety & Community Reports- None.

 - a. Update on Resolution on Long-Term Street Parking- Secretary Porter said the ordinance is still working its way through County Counsel, who has to make sure the ordinance will be specific to Spring Valley Lake and won't apply to the entire county.

Public Works will install an upcoming stop sign on Driftwood near Spring Valley Lake Parkway, along with a sign of double arrows. The Chair mentioned ensuring CHP with still continue to enforce long-term parking with the new ordinance. The Chair also requested we get a timeline on the upcoming stop sign installation, and inquire again as to flashing lights.
