Draft Resolution No. 2026-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE SPRING VALLEY LAKE MUNICIPAL ADVISORY COUNCIL REQUESTING THAT THE COUNTY OF SAN BERNARDINO PAINT AND ESTABLISH AN ONGOING MAINTENANCE PLAN FOR SPECIFIED SECTIONS OF THE EXTERIOR BLOCK WALL SURROUNDING SPRING VALLEY LAKE

WHEREAS, the exterior block wall surrounding the Spring Valley Lake community is approximately fifty (50) years old; and

WHEREAS, little maintenance has been performed on portions of the exterior-facing wall over the years; and

WHEREAS, sections of the wall are currently in visible disrepair, including fading, surface deterioration, and staining; and

WHEREAS, the deteriorated condition of the wall detracts from the appearance, safety perception, and overall aesthetic quality of the Spring Valley Lake community; and

WHEREAS, maintaining community infrastructure contributes to neighborhood pride, property values, and overall quality of life;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Spring Valley Lake Municipal Advisory Council formally requests that the County of San Bernardino paint the following exterior-facing sections of the block wall surrounding Spring Valley Lake:

- The wall along Pah Ute Road from Spring Valley Parkway to Ridgecrest Road; and
- The wall along Ridgecrest Road from Pah Ute Road to Chinquapin Road, including all returns, as well as both returns on Chinquapin.

2. The painting shall include proper surface preparation, repair of damaged sections where feasible, and application of durable exterior coating appropriate for masonry surfaces.

3. The Spring Valley Lake Municipal Advisory Council further requests that the County of San Bernardino develop and implement an ongoing maintenance plan for the exterior wall, including periodic inspection, cleaning, repair, and repainting as necessary to preserve the appearance and structural integrity of the wall.

4. Regarding the painting of the wall, including paint color and designs, please see the attached picture.

5. That this resolution be transmitted to the Office of San Bernardino County First District Supervisor, Col. Paul Cook (Ret.) and the appropriate County departments for review and action.
